Consultancy Services for Project Management and Supervision for the Construction of Lessos 400/220kV, Gilgil 400/22kV & Kimuka 400/220kV Substations Project.

This request for expression of interest follows the general procurement notice (GPN) for the Construction of Kimuka 400/220kV, Gilgil 400/220kV and Lessos 400/220kV substations that appeared in the local dailies on 6th May 2016 and on the external website of the World Bank on 3rd June 2016.

The GOVERNMENT OF KENYA has received funding for financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the construction of the Gilgil, Lessos and Kimuka 400/220kV substations, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The Consultancy Services include:

- Preparation and submission to KETRACO and the World Bank of a detailed project implementation schedule,
- Review and approval of contractor's design documents,
- Supervision of construction works and certification of contractors payments,
- Contract administration and management.
- Preparation of monthly and quarterly progress reports and,
- Preparation of Project Completion Report.

Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- At least five (5) years of the relevant experience in Sub-Saharan Africa.
