1.	Bidders are, at a minimum, required to provide for the key personnel listed in pages 84-87 of the RFP. Please confirm whether bidders can list employees of their sub-consultants as key personnel;	Yes, bidders are permitted to designate employees of their sub-consultants as key personnel.
2.	Please confirm whether the “Comprehensive and Detailed Project Implementation Plan” referred to under Paragraph 1 of Page 89 of the RFP is required to accompany the technical proposal; and	Yes, this is required to be submitted as part of the Technical Proposal.
3.	Paragraph 3 in page 89 of the RFP provides that “The TA shall make presentations to KETRACO on each deliverable...with the team’s key experts present.” Please confirm whether: a) all of the team’s key experts will be required during the presentations referred to above; and b) whether the key experts can attend the presentations virtually.	The Team Leader is required to be physically present during the presentations, along with the majority of key experts. While some key experts may participate virtually, further details will be finalized during contract negotiations, based on the submitted and agreed-upon project implementation plan.
4.	In the Aerial Survey & Mapping section under Task 1.5 of Phase 1, a Vertical and Horizontal Primary Survey is requested.
