GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

1. The Government of Kenya has received financing from the African Development Bank ("AfDB") and Korean Exim Bank ("EDCF") toward the cost of the implementation of Kenya Transmission Network Improvement Project (KTRNIP),

The main development objective of the proposed project is to improve; - power transfer capacity, quality of electricity supply, supply reliability of high voltage (HV) transmission network and enhance socio-economic development in the targeted areas. It also supports to improve efficiency of supply by reducing technical losses and providing evacuation alternatives for renewable (particularly solar, geothermal and hydro) power generation sites in the project targeted areas.
